

ORDINANCE OF LORAIN BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 268

**AN ORDINANCE OF LORAIN BOROUGH, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA MODIFYING AND AMENDING LORAIN BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 248 BY ADOPTING REVISED LOCAL LIMITS FOR THE DISCHARGE OR POLLUTANTS FROM INDUSTRIAL AND OTHER SIGNIFICANT USERS ESTABLISHED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN**

**Whereas**, the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Johnstown owns and operates a regional sewage treatment plant serving residents and businesses in 20 municipalities including Lorain Borough, and

**Whereas**, Lorain Borough Ordinance No. 248 provides for the adoption by reference, the "Rates, Rules and Regulations for Johnstown Regional Sewage Regarding the Use of the Sewage Collection or Treatment Systems" only as currently adopted by the Johnstown Regional Sewage ("JRS"); and

**Whereas**, Lorain Borough Ordinance No. 248 also provides that typical domestic levels shall be documented in a set of local limits for pollutants, capable of effecting efficient operation of the sewage treatment plant, as set forth in Appendix "A" of the "Rates, Rules, and Regulations that are attached thereto; and

**Whereas**, on January 17, 2017, JRA adopted Resolution No. 4296 which modified some of the Local Limits in Appendix "A" of Lorain Borough Ordinance No. 248; and

**Now therefore**, the Governing Body of the Borough of Lorain hereby adopts the following ordinance to modify and amend Lorain Borough Ordinance No. 248 as follows:

Section 1.


- A. Appendix "A" attached to Lorain Borough Ordinance No. 248 is hereby amended to reflect that:
- (1) the Local Limits attached as Appendix "A" to JRA Resolution No. 4296 are hereby adopted by reference by Lorain Borough and attached hereto as Appendix "A"; and
  - (2) the following surcharges established by JRA in Resolution No. 4296 shall be imposed upon customers contributing flow constituents in excess of typical domestic levels, as follows:
    - a. A surcharge of \$0.18 per pound of BOD for ROD entering the sewage system in excess of 1000 mg/l;
    - b. A surcharge of \$0.06 per pound of Oil and Grease for Oil and Grease entering the sewage system in excess of 600 mg/l;
    - c. A surcharge of \$0.23 per pound of Total Suspended Solids ("TSS"), for TSS entering the sewage system in excess of 500 500mg/l.

Section 2.


- A. The remaining sections of Lorain Borough Ordinance No. 248 remain unchanged to the extent that any of the remaining sections are not in conflict with the provisions set forth in this ordinance.






