

**ORDINANCE OF LORAIN BOROUGH, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2011**

Ordinance No. 254

BE ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of Lorain Borough, Cambria County, Pennsylvania the following:

SECTION 1: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real estate within the Borough of Lorain subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2011 as follows:

- A: The tax rate for general purposes shall equal the sum of twelve (12) mils of each dollar of assessed valuation, up from ten (10) mils in previous years.

- B: The two (2) mil tax levied on each dollar of assessed valuation of real estate in Lorain Borough for the purpose of establishing a fund for the purchase of a new fire engine for Lorain Borough that was established by Ordinance No. 218 which was adopted by Lorain Borough Council on December 1, 1993, was repealed by Ordinance No. 253 known as the "Lorain Borough Fire Engine Tax Repeal Ordinance of 2010" adopted by Lorain Borough Council on Oct 13, 2010, to be effective January 1, 2011.

SECTION 2: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all earned income subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2011 as follows:

- A. The tax rate for earned income shall be one-half of one percent on all earned income.

SECTION 3: That a per capita tax be and the same is hereby levied on all residents subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2011 as follows:

- A. The per capita tax rate for residents shall be \$5.00.

SECTION 4: That a flat rate occupation tax be and the same is hereby levied on all persons subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2011 as follows:

- A. The flat rate occupation tax rate for all persons shall be \$10.00.

SECTION 5: That for the expenses, salaries, and wages for fiscal year 2011, the amounts appropriated from the revenues available for fiscal year 2011 and for the purposes set forth and itemized in the Budget Form on file in the Borough office and passed by the Council of Lorain Borough.

SECTION 6: That any ordinance, or part of any ordinance, that conflicts with this ordinance or any part of is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.


